Dalí: Poetics of the Small, 1929–1936 Extended Through January 6, 2019

- **WHAT:** The Meadows Museum's exhibition *Dalí: Poetics of the Small,* 1929–1936 has been extended through January 6, 2019.
- WHEN: Effective immediately
- **WHERE:** 5900 Bishop Blvd., Dallas, TX 75205 Free parking available in the Meadows Museum Garage

**WHY:** *Dalí: Poetics of the Small, 1929–1936,* the first in-depth exploration of the small-scale paintings by Salvador Dalí (1904–1989), has been extended until January 6, 2019. Lenders to the exhibition have unanimously agreed to extend their loans in order to offer Dallas audiences the extraordinary opportunity to view this special exhibition through the holiday season and into the new year. All save one of the original 21 paintings in the show will now remain on view at the Meadows Museum through January 6, 2019. *The Weaning of Furniture-Nutrition* (1934) will remain in Dallas only through the exhibition's original end date (Dec. 9, 2018), due to its prior commitment to another exhibition. Regular hours for the Meadows Museum are: Tuesday–Saturday 10:00 a.m.–5:00 p.m., open late on Thursdays until 9:00 p.m., and Sunday 1:00–5:00 p.m. The museum will be closed Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day. Admission is \$12 for adults, \$10 for seniors, and \$4 for non-SMU students; admission is free for SMU faculty, staff and students, children under 12, and Thursday evenings 5:00–9:00 p.m.
