

This exhibition celebrates the museum's unique association with the university. For the first time, the Meadows will host highlights from nine distinct campus collections at once, including the Underwood Law Library, G. William Jones Film and Video Collection, Bywaters Special Collections, Hamon Arts Library, the Shuler Museum of Paleontology, DeGolyer Library, the Archaeology Research Collections, Bridwell Library and the noted University Art Collection. Over 100 exquisite works of art, intriguing artifacts, and rare specimens will be on display, many of which will be exhibited outside their home departments for the first time.
