HAVE FUN AND BE CURIOUS! ENCOURAGE STUDENTS TO ASK QUESTIONS AND SHARE IDEAS. IF YOU HAVE QUESTIONS OR COMMENTS, FEEL FREE TO SHARE THEM, BUT PLEASE ALLOW STUDENTS TO SHARE THEIR THOUGHTS FIRST.

WHAT IS THE ADMISSION PRICE?

During the 2023–2024 academic year, schools can bring up to 1 chaperone per every 10 students for FREE. thanks to a grant from Fichtenbaum Charitable Trust, Bank of America, N.A., Co-Trustee. If your school has additional chaperones, the cost is \$4 per person.

WHERE SHOULD I PARK?

Great news! Parking is free for museum visitors. The museum is located at 5900 Bishop Boulevard, Dallas, TX 75205. The entrance to the museum's underground parking garage is at the corner of Bishop Boulevard and Schlegel Street.

WHAT AM I ALLOWED TO BRING?

You may bring a small bag or purse. Umbrellas, backpacks, or other bulky items are not allowed in the galleries. Additionally, no food or drinks are allowed in the galleries. Writing and sketching materials may be brought in, but are limited to reasonably sized notebooks, pencils, crayons, and oil pastels. Large or sharp objects are prohibited.

CAN I TAKE PICTURES?

We encourage non-flash photography and videography with handheld devices for personal use. If you decide to post on social media, don't forget to tag us! There may be a few objects under copyright protection and thus may NOT be photographed. These objects are identified with a 'no photography' icon on their labels.

WHERE CAN WE EAT LUNCH?
