MEADOWS MUSEUM TRANSPORTATION SCHOLARSHIP

K12 schools are eligible to receive a maximum scholarship of \$200 to cover the cost of transportation to and from the museum. Schools may be awarded up to two scholarships per calendar year.

PRIORITY ELIGIBILITY:

- Schools located within 50 miles of SMU.
- Schools serving a student population comprised of at least 50% who qualify for free or reduced lunch under the National School Lunch Program.
- Schools who have not been awarded a transit scholarship previously.

SCHOLARSHIP PROCEDURES:

To apply for the scholarship, a teacher or school administrator must submit the below application. Applications must be submitted at least three weeks in advance of the field trip. Scholarships will be awarded to qualifying schools on a first come first served basis. Applications should be sent to:

The school will be notified of their award via email. Upon notification the school is to submit an invoice on school or district letterhead, a receipt from their bus company, and a completed W9. When all documents have been submitted, the Meadows Museum will reimburse the school or district directly.
