assistants

i.e. oil paint, marble,  
ink, or collage

the plural of the  
material an artwork is  
made of

the way an artist uses  
tools and materials

individual parts of an  
artwork

how the parts of an  
artwork are arranged

i.e. straight, curved,  
thick, or thin

what we see when  
light reflects off an  
object

how something feels

a three-dimensional  
shape

i.e. realistic, abstract,  
expressive, etc.

a style of art that does  
not show things exactly  
as they look

when artists paint or  
draw outside

what an artwork is  
about

an object, shape, or  
color that stands for  
something else

the feeling or emotion  
of an artwork

the way an artist shows  
emotions, ideas, or  
energy

when an artwork  
communicates a  
message about society
